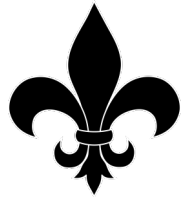

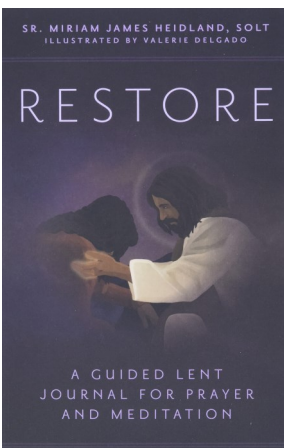


## FIRST COMMUNION
