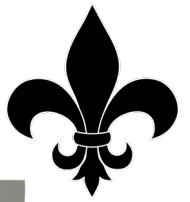

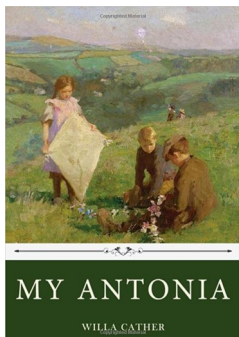

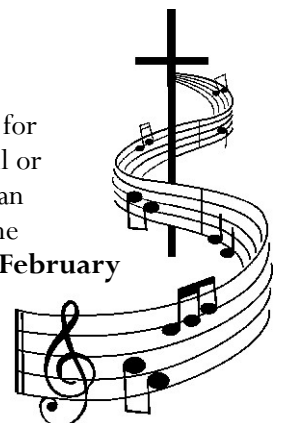

We remember the Passion and Jesus' sacrifice for us on the cross.

Easter is an 8 day celebration leading to Easter Season, which ends on Pentecost.
