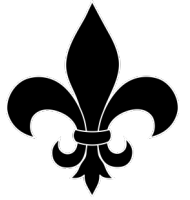

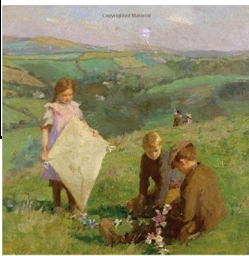

Please note the following schedule changes as we approach Lent:

Starting Monday, February 20th throughout Lent, there will be **no 12:05pm Daily Mass on Mondays**. Eucharistic Adoration will take place as usual until Benediction at Noon followed by the Rosary for Life.

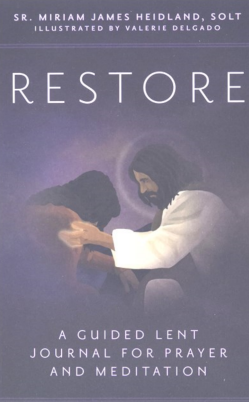

## Restore... a Women's Lenten Retreat

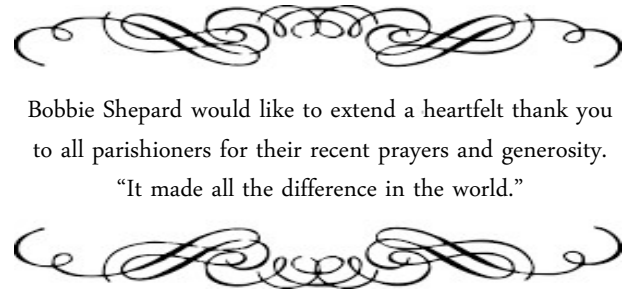
