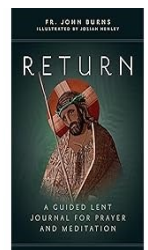
## LENT Pray + Fast + Give

Father Gilbaugh will be in Rome February 5th—13th. There will be no daily Masses at either parish.

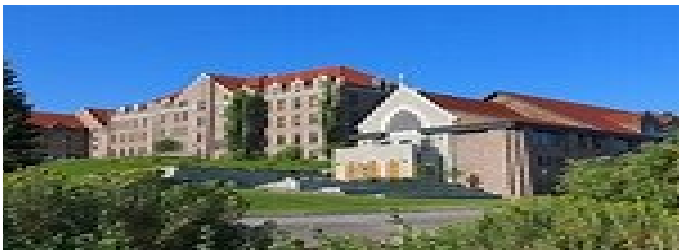
