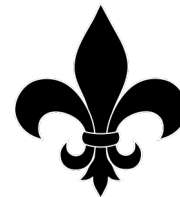

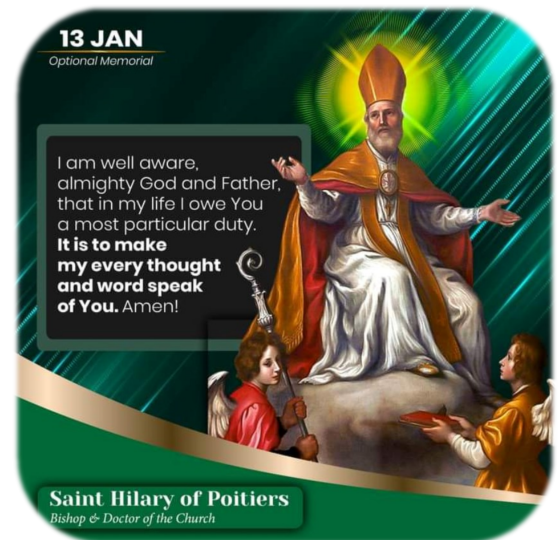

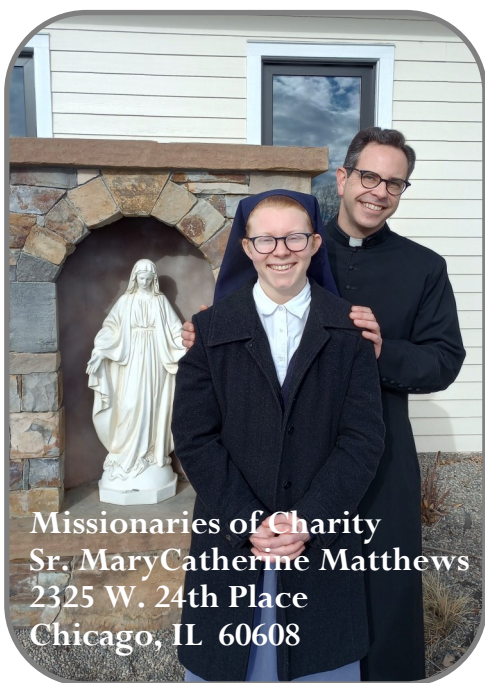
Catholic Summer Camp Scholarships

St. Martha's Altar Society is again offering scholarships to attend the Diocese of Helena's Legendary Lodge Summer Camps. This year, the scholarships have been expanded to also include other Catholic summer camps. Students of the parish entering grades 5 thru 12 are eligible; one \$400 scholarship, one \$200 scholarship, and ten \$100 scholarships will be awarded.

Families are able to receive more than one scholarship if two or more children apply. **The scholarship application deadline is Sunday, January 28th.** Find applications and more information in the vestibule. **One of the Legendary Lodge camps is already full, all are over 50% and most are already 80% full, so register soon!** Call the parish office with any questions.

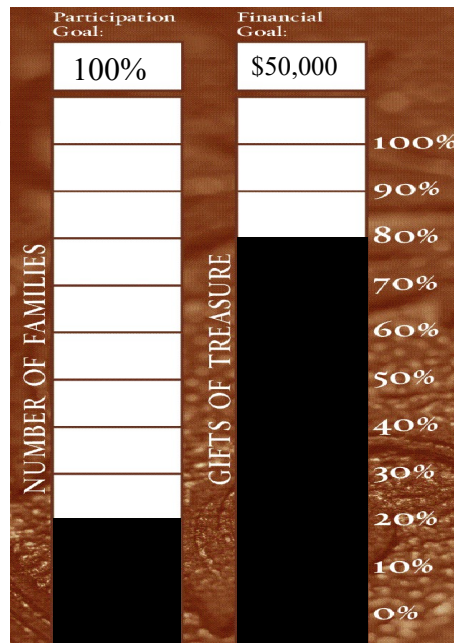
